Passes are issued at the Fulton USDA office – some members present reported some problems of the issuing person being at the USDA when they attempted to get the pass.

James Aldridge has provided some additional info on the America the Beautiful Passes for those interested. The UADA works with the4 US Forestry Service on the passes. The local Columbia Office does not seem to know anything about the passes. Carol Troke (sp?) with the US Forestry Service overseeing Mark Twain National Forest is the contact to obtain these passes. Her work cell is 573 201-8527. She works from home but she will meet at the USDA office at 4549 State Hwy H, Fulton, MO 65251 to sell the passes by appointment. You have to be 62 and will need 10.00 and a photo ID to qualify. The pass includes the card and the hangtag holder.

James advises she will be out of town Thursday and Friday this week but will be at the office today (Wed) at 3PM to meet Danny Aldridge to issue him a pass. If convenient you could tag up with Danny on Wed or I'm Sure you could make an appointment sometime next week to get one of the passes.
